# SAVE THE WHEATSHEAF

## Greens oppose developers threatening to close historic performance venue

Greens are working with campaigners to save the historic Wheatsheaf pub from a re-development that will result in the loss of the live performance space and the upstairs bar.

Green Party candidate Dianne said, *“The Wheatsheaf is a cultural landmark bringing in diverse voices to our City. I will represent your voice at council to ensure that spaces like this; that are historic and vibrant, remain protected.”*

The Greens are supporting an application for the venue to be registered as an ‘asset of community value’, which offers some legal protection from re-development.



## GREENS SECURE SUPPORT FOR FOOD POVERTY STRATEGY

### Further successes rounds off a good Council year for the Greens in Oxford

At the last full Oxford City Council meeting in March, a Green party motion to address the causes of food inequality in Oxford, highlighted by the current pandemic, passed with cross-party support following a ‘friendly’ amendment by Labour.

Green Candidate Dianne says, *“It is inhuman that, even in Oxford, some families still struggle to put food on the table; it is a basic right to be sufficiently fed each day. As your Councillor, I will fight for every child and adult to have three nutritional meals every day of the year.”*

Other recent Green successes include:

- A commitment to introduce an Oxford Living Rent,
- Presenting an alternative City Council budget which would have provided more money for homelessness, climate action and community grants
- A commitment to support real ‘net zero’ carbon buildings
